Enrolment Criteria

Marcellin College was established by the Marist Brothers in 1950 and today is a leader in boys' education from Years 7 to 12. Through virtue and courage, our students are presented with opportunities to strive for the highest as they become responsible citizens and positive role models for others.

The College prides itself on inclusiveness and welcomes enrolments from students with varying academic ability, faith and nationality.

The following Enrolment Criteria applies to students wishing to submit an application to enrol at Marcellin College:

1. Brothers of current or former students of Marcellin College.
2. Sons of past students who attended Marcellin College.
3. Boys transferring from other Marist schools.
4. Catholic and Orthodox boys who reside in a Marcellin College Feeder Parish and are attending a Catholic Primary School. *Preference will be given to the Catholic Primary Schools listed below, which are located in our Feeder Parish.*
5. Catholic and Orthodox boys who reside in the Marcellin College Feeder Parish but are not attending a Catholic Primary School.
6. Catholic and Orthodox boys who reside outside the Marcellin College Feeder Parish area.
7. Non-Catholic boys attending a Catholic Primary School.
8. Non-Catholic boys attending other schools.

Once you have created your account and completed your son's enrolment, you will be required to upload copies of the following documents:

- Birth Certificate
- Baptism Certificate (if applicable)

If your son is not an Australian citizen, please also provide a copy of your son's Passport/Australian Residency.

The enrolment process for Year 7 will commence when your son is in Year 5.

Your son will be required to attend an interview prior to a formal offer being made.

The offer of enrolment is at the discretion of the Principal who will consider each case on its merits and take account of any special circumstances. Please refer to the College website to view our Enrolment Policy and Enrolment Terms and Conditions.

Late applications will be processed, where possible, with consideration given to our Enrolment Criteria and the date of receipt.
