## Class of 2022 Academic Results

Dear Members of the Marcellin College Community,

Please join me in congratulating the Class of 2022 who today received confirmation on the successful completion of their Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) and Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL).

We have much to celebrate and be proud of.

Congratulations to the 2022 College Dux **Robert Spencer-He** on achieving an ATAR of 98.45 and being the subject Dux of English Language, Psychology, Chemistry and Chinese Language: Culture and Society, and to the Proxime Accessit **Jared McCormick** for achieving an ATAR of 97.8.

We are also delighted to share key highlights from the Class of 2022:

- Seven Study Scores of 50 for Further Mathematics, Biology, Mathematics Methods and Visual Communication Design, two of which were obtained by a Year 11 student
- 52% of students received an ATAR of 70 or above (an increase from 50% in 2021)
- The College achieved a median ATAR of 71.15 which is above the State average
- The College median Study Score was 30
- The median Study Score for History Revolutions was 36
- The median Study Score for English Language was 32
- The median Study Score for Visual Communication Design was 34
- 31% of Further Mathematics students obtained an A or A+ on one or more examination
- 30% of Religious Education: Religion and Society examination scores were an A or A+
- 35% of Visual Communication Design examination scores were an A or A+
- In addition, 11 students were awarded the VCE Baccalaureate 'which is an additional form of recognition for students who successfully meet the demands of studying a higher-level mathematics subject and a language in their VCE program' (VCAA).

It has not been the easiest of times with the uncertainties of the pandemic these past few years. However, these students have embraced the many opportunities given to them, reaching their full potential as learners and attaining the results they deserved.

Please join me in congratulating these fine young men as they forge ahead with Marist values to guide them. We look forward to seeing the impact they will make on the world. May they continue to *strive for the highest* in all that they do.

As we look towards 2023, may we continue to foster a love of learning and life and we wish our graduates all the very best as they move into the next phase of their lives.
